**DEPUTY NATIONAL SAFETY OFFICER (INLAND) REPORT FOR NATIONAL COUNCIL MEETING TO BE HELD ON 7 February 2020**

In a recent **interim** restructure of SADSAA Safety, I was allocated the responsibility for Border, Eastern Cape and Southern Cape. Carl, Lyn and I will share the responsibility for the Inland Provinces. I am still trying to find my feet with this responsibility. With the festive season behind us, and all back from holiday, I will focus on this during the next months.

I attended the Border Provincial Meeting. The meeting was extremely well attended by Safety Officers. It was an extremely fruitful meeting under the leadership of Tyrone Gower. A number of safety issues were discussed and clarified. Thank you for the hospitality.

I will arrange with Martin Gierz, and Chris Schorn to attend the next Eastern Province and Southern Cape meetings. Herewith a summary of important issues post the October Council Meeting:

**1. Marine Notices:**

Marine Notice 3 of 2020: This Notice deals with the Assumed Weight per person for the purpose of calculating Built-in Bouyancy requirements. The assumed weight is increased from 75kg to 82.5kg.

Please note the following:

- The above MN is not applicable to Passenger Vessels and Pontoons. MN 17 of 2015 and MN 26 of 2011 remains in force for these vessels.
- The MN only applies to vessels built or constructed after 1 March 2020.

**2. Surveyor and Examiner Audit Schedule for 2020**

Full audits will be conducted this year. Below is a proposed schedule of audits. Provincial Chairmen are requested to communicate this to their Surveyors and Examiners.
