Standard Operating Procedure: Launching of Ski-boats:

- A member's vessel may not proceed to sea without a valid COF/LGSC & Skipper.
- The Member must be present and must produce their membership card to security which must include a slipway access sticker on the back of it.
- All boats must have a valid "launching disc", which is issued by the club's front office staff on receipt of the member's valid COF/LGSC.
- The owner/responsible skipper will be required to sign out before launching and sign in on return.
- Ski boat jetty Town side is for drop and go only, please keep clear.
- Ski boat jetty marina side we can use for temporary tie up if using club facilities such as bar/restaurant/ablutions. If you are launching from a trailer on your own and thus leave your vehicle and trailer in the slipway for a time, please launch and retrieve to one side of the slip out of the way of other users and tie up your boat on the inside of the jetty or closest to the club house also out of the way of other drop and go users.
- Parking trailers & vehicles in demarcated bays – please ensure that you do not cross bays. If none available, separating your vehicle and trailer you can use single bays. Weekends and public holidays park neatly other side of the wall in naval yard. You can also drop your trailer off at IMT parking area further down the road.
- Observe the no-wake zone and be cautious of very small craft such as paddlers and rowers.

Use of the Flake Ice Machine:

- Ice will only be issued on presentation of a valid pre-paid voucher to the security office at the entrance.
- No cash will be accepted by the security office. Sales of vouchers are through the club office only, during 09h00-15h00 on weekdays and 09h00-13h00 on weekends & public holidays.
- **Members** may purchase vouchers at R35 per single voucher/R700 per booklet and may take a maximum of 5 bags of ice per boat, per day.
- **Non-members** may purchase vouchers at R70 per single voucher/R1400 per booklet and may take a maximum of 2 bags of ice per boat, per day, subject to availability.
- A reusable bag per voucher will be supplied to you when you redeem your voucher for ice.
- New bags for fish/ice are also available from the club office at R60 per packet of 50. These are extra-heavy duty, reusable & washable.
- Complete the ice register at the security office and ask for the key to the container. Use the plastic spade correctly inside the container to fill your bag/s.
- Lock the container correctly and return the key to security.

Standard Operating Procedure: Parking of Vehicles and Trailers:

Members are reminded to please park their vehicles and trailers in a responsible manner at all times. The municipal car park outside of the yacht club is owned by

the City of Cape Town, which has allocated 2 long bays for vehicles and trailers as per photo.



On weekends and public holidays, parking for members with trailer boats is available on the SA Navy property in the East Yard at Cole Point Gate (next to FBYC). Once members have signed out and launched their vessel, the vehicle and trailer are to be parked in the East Yard. See diagram below. Specific parking regulations are to be followed in accordance with SA Navy rules.
